1 - Latest research updates:

US death trends due to acute renal failure.

This is a preliminary analysis of renal failure death rates for younger individuals (aged 35-44) in the US, in 2021, 2022 and 2023, which points to an extreme phenomenon at play, which is not being investigated. We hope that our preliminary analysis leads to deeper investigations.
