Dear Humanity Projects subscribers,

We are releasing research on deaths and disabilities from malignant neoplasms in England and Wales for young individuals aged 15 to 44. Our research provides strong evidence showing the increased trend in malignant neoplasm deaths, which rose by substantial amounts in 2021 and 2022. Our results are highly statistically significant and corroborate the anecdotes we observe on sudden deaths in the population.

We are also releasing a complementary report that investigates the most common individual cancer deaths, which provides richer information for medical doctors who want to understand the underlying phenomenon at play.

Additionally, we also released some of our projects for external funding. This will help us expand our infrastructure, including our webservers.
