We recently updated the PIP data that analyses new disability claims in the UK. We observe that some diseases continue to reach new maximums for disability claims while others have subsided in recent months. Overall, the data shows that the rate of new disability claims has not subsided significantly and is still at very high levels. Analysis of which diseases are rising and falling is of interest for healthcare professionals who are trying to understand the phenomenon of morbidity that we observe around us.

We also reviewed the papers from Korea that provide population-based studies in the rise of non-fatal diseases that compare rates in vaccinated versus unvaccinated individuals. The results corroborate our PIP analysis.

Additionally, we also released some of our projects for external funding. This will help us expand our infrastructure, including our webservers.
